Are You An Adult Catholic, But Not Yet Confirmed?

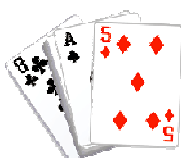

MOVIE NIGHT for children GRADES 3-5. Saturday February 4 7-9:30 pm.

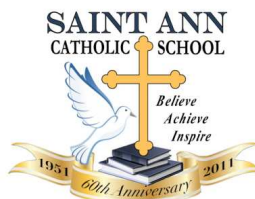

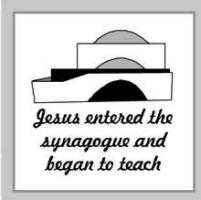
