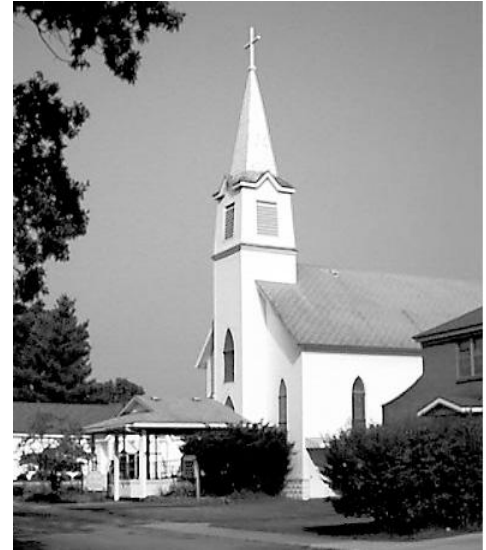

The Communion rite concludes with another prayer.

This time it is not a prayer of thanksgiving; rather, we now ask for the fruits of the Eucharist. We pray that the sacrament may have an effect in our lives that it will

- Lead us to share Christ's eternal life
- Have the Lord touch our lives
- Teach us the way to everlasting glory
- Continue the saving work of the Eucharist

These prayers, together with the prayers over the gifts we heard just before the Eucharistic Prayer, offer a rich and diverse vision of what the Eucharist can do in our lives and in our communities, if we are aware and open to it.
