#### **Green Tip of the Week**

When we flush meds down drains or send them to landfills, they make their way into

rivers and even drinking water. Proper disposal is just what the doctor ordered.

- **Healthier aquatic life.** More than 80% of rivers recently sampled tested positive for meds like antibiotics, birth control, hormones, and antidepressants.
- **Safer drinking water.** Trace amounts of pharmaceuticals end up in our H2O because most treatment plants aren't designed to filter them out.
- **Helping people who can't afford meds.** Many states have programs that'll take your drugs and redistribute them. Many pharmacies, such as Rite Aid, have safe drug disposal programs; check with yours.
