The Ministry of “Respecting God’s Creation” Green Tip of the Week

Reminder of Earth Friendly Lawn Care Tips:

- Battle weeds with toxin-free tactics that are healthier for your kids (and pets)! Pour boiling water or white vinegar on smaller weeds (like the ones in your sidewalk cracks). There are also toxin-free products on the market, such as Deadeye or WOW.
- Water your lawn in the early morning. Up to 30% of water used for midday watering will evaporate, while nighttime watering causes your garden to stay damp longer, sometimes leading to mold.
- Raise the level of your lawn mower to 2 or 3 inches. Longer grass keeps moisture better because it shades the roots. And while you’re at it, switch to a reel (good for your heart & creation!) or electric mower instead of a high-polluting gaspowered one.
