Committee Reports

1. Liturgy

Bob Voyt said that in April of 2010 the Greer family offered to donate a grand piano to the church. There was discussion about how much it would cost to get it fixed. The Greer's offered to donate \$1000 to repair the piano. Because of the lengthy process of approval of the piano it was given to a family member. A check for \$2000 was donated to the church in lieu of the piano. If the piano should become available again, the church would be contacted. There was discussion about how the \$2000 should be spent. Dick Conley suggested that the money should be used for music because it was Mrs. Greer's expertise. Marj said that the money should be held aside for something musical. Please report back next month how much money it will cost to replace the hymnals. Father said that a thank you letter should be written.

Marj Redder doesn't have any new recruits for liturgy.

Dick Conley wondered if we have plan for youth liturgy.

2. Building and Grounds

Ralph Jr. was hired to do ground work around the church. Tom Bieberle said a new patio is being put in for Father's rectory. Next week cement will be poured. Al Deuling will be doing a new roof. It will match the new roof on the church. An estimate for new carpeting will be gotten and new carpet will be installed in the spring.

Ralph said there is a problem with organization in the kitchen. He is working on organizing the flat ware on a wheeled cart. This should cut down on some problems. The area dedicated to funeral crowds is crowded. Ralph has bought a new shelf to improve the back corner. Everything will be relocated on the back shelf.

Ralph is looking at getting the carpet in the hall, the hallway and the office cleaned in November. November is an off month for the renting of the hall.

Tom B. brought up a concern about the number of cigarette butts in the parking lot after receptions on Saturday night. There was discussion about how to handle this problem. Bonnie said that there is a committee called the "Dead Heads" that goes

around cleaning up our community. There is a problem with this around town Bonnie said. Ralph said he would make added mentions about this to the stewards and renters.

There was discussion about people being so intoxicated at the wedding receptions that there was vomit in the parking lot. Dick Conley and Arvie Shinavier said that the neighbors are complaining about the noise at the parties. Some said we should not rent the hall. Ralph said that most weddings are well controlled. Ralph thinks we are over reacting. Tom said that we should increase the stewards depending on the number of people at the receptions.

Helen said the kitchen was left in a mess on Tuesday. There was chocolate on the counter. The grounds were still in the coffee pot. This was Tuesday. Was there an event on Monday? Please monitor this.

Arvie said the stained glass wall needs repair. This will be taken care of.

Christian Service

46 lbs. of food donated \$400 donated to be doubled by the Fremont Area Community Foundation.

Education

Tomorrow night is the kick off for religious education. There will be a taco dinner served while students register. Larry and Marj will be there to encourage participation and give information about how people can get involved. Classes will start on Sept. 28. Books are expensive. \$1500 was spent on new books with the new Roman missal. Jill's computer isn't working well. CCW was approached about a new computer. They purchased her a new laptop.

Jill is anticipating more students to be enrolled for CCD this year. Peggy and Jill handle "Protecting God's Children." Tiffany Brown is working on starting a nursery during mass. Jill will try to get the volunteers to attend the Protecting God's Children this Sunday afternoon.

Joe talked about the Rejoice Youth Group. He talked about 3 objectives for this group. A facebook group page has been created. They are working on making active participants of our youth. They would like a monthly youth mass. This hasn't been organized yet. They want to develop a process for each meeting time. Parish Life and Youth Group should run congruently. It will be parish wide. Joe said he is growing with this process. He wants a self-perpetuating process. When will the first youth group mass be? Sherry asked Joe to get the schedule to Cindy.

Helen has one candidate for RCIA. The class is going well.

Father Peter said "without the youth there is no future."

Finance

Arvie spoke. See included sheet. The last 3 Sundays have been down about \$1,000. There are many reasons for this. Some are paying monthly, some have moved. It makes it difficult. Some of the winter bills are paid with Fish Fry funds.

Overall, the parishioners are good at supporting us. Arvie said the facility is roughly 10 years old. Money was raised to start the building process and we still have a mortgage. We are doing the best we can financially.

Parish Life

Sherry and Bonnie wanted to thank Steve Pope for the gifts at the picnic. Bonnie will no longer chair Parish Life and neither will Sherry. No money was charged for the picnic. Volleyball was played all day. Thanks to everyone in the parish for everything that has been done. Anna Heger won the M&Ms. It was recommended to continue the parish picnic. Father thanked everyone who worked.

Joe said we have our first "Celebration Sunday" this weekend. There is a long list of birthdays and anniversaries. Also, the All Saints celebration will be celebrated on the 30th of October. It will be a breakfast casserole potluck after 8:30 mass. Father will look into getting a sub to celebrate mass at St. Joseph's so he can be here for the celebration. Joe will ask CCW to help. This will be a free-will offering.

Tom Bieberle said that we have had a Wine and Cheese thank you traditionally. Joe told Tom that he will be happy to delegate that to someone else. Parish Life will not be doing the Wine and Cheese thank you evening. This has been in October on a week day evening and Sherry says that we should still do it. Last year it was at the Stone Lodge. Sherry wants to know if anyone will look into it. Dory said she would look into this thank you evening for our volunteers.

Visitation Ministry

Sherry promised Anna that she would be vigilant about finding someone to do this. It will take about 2 hours to do this on Friday mornings. It was suggested to ask Jennifer Goscicki to do this ministry.

Sherry has a map of the Holy Spirit at All Saints. Sherry would like this to go into next week's bulletin. Sherry handed out a Directory / Map / Flow Chart.

Marj asked if anyone would be willing to take over the religious store. Jill suggested Odile Mangin.

Dick wondered who would do the All Saints news letter. He suggested we ask Kay Cummings or Sandy Siegel.
