## Time After TYME Workshops Grades 9-12

All 6 workshops offered this year are part of the required Diocesan Curriculum. Public school youth should be taking a minimum of 2 workshops per year; those in the Confirmation program should only take 2 workshops. Catholic School youth cover the Diocesan Curriculum in school, but you are invited to sign up for TAT workshops that might be of special interest. There is a required minimum of 5 students per session and a cap at 15 students.

### 2009/2010 Workshop Offerings

\****Sacrament Basics***— Sacraments: we know what they are, but what do they mean? Study how the sacraments relate to salvation and examine each sacrament in detail within the liturgical life of the Church.

\****Bible Basics 101***— Basic knowledge of the Bible. Covers how to find passages in the Bible, the Old and New Testament, how to interpret the Bible, and how it is used in the Liturgy. Bibles will be provided, but you may bring your own.

\****Picture Perfect***—Created in God's image. Different, yet alike—What do we hold in common? What are our rights and responsibilities as Children of God?

\****A Year of Fashion***—Why is Father wearing pink? How does the liturgical year differ from the calendar year? Examine the reasons for the different colors, decorations, musical selections, practices and focus of the readings seen throughout the church year.

\* ***Unlocking the History of the Catholic Church*** – “You are Peter and on this rock I will build my church.” A brief jog in time from the early church until today.

\****Scripture in Liturgy***— Prayers in Liturgy, where did the Catholic Church find those?? Connecting our liturgical prayers to scripture.
