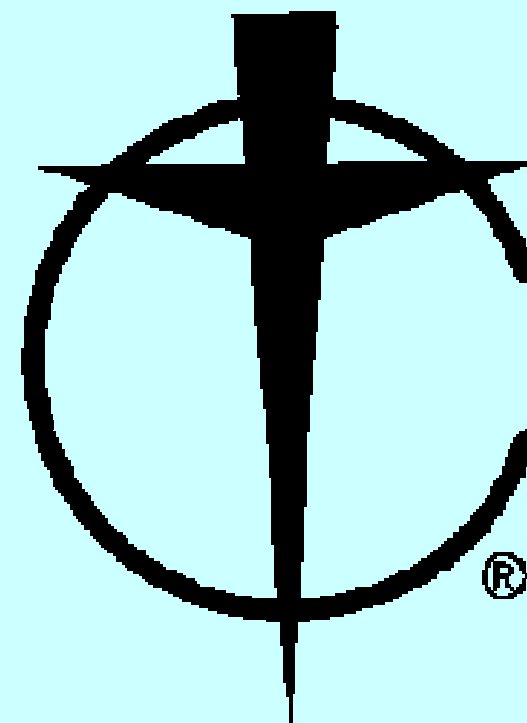
From I64, take Exit 137 toward

## WHAT IS LEADER'S SCHOOL?

Leader's School is a group of Cursillistas who come together to share our faith, to deepen our own formation, and to provide direction for Cursillo in the diocese.

Leader's School is a way to grow in our knowledge about the Cursillo movement. We talk about Cursillo techniques (what it is, how it works, how did it develop, how is continues 50 years after its introduction to the US) as well as Catholic Church teachings (especially those applying to us as laypeople living in the world).

Leader's School is a group working to better live and understand the Cursillo method and all that means in our daily lives. We try to enhance our own ongoing conversion while developing our knowledge of Cursillo.

The purpose of Leader's School is to:

1. Establish, sustain and encourage group reunions.
2. Prepare and encourage Ultreyas.
3. Train leaders in the Cursillo mentality.
4. Introduce people from the Precursillo into the Postcursillo.
