

ST. ANNE CYO GIRLS BASKETBALL

Welcome to St. Anne's CYO Girls basketball program.

This program is open to all girls who are in St. Anne's CCD Religious Education program or girls that live within St. Anne's Parish boundaries (West of Hwy. 880, North of the Alameda Creek, by Lowry Rd. in Fremont/Union City, and up to the Union City/Hayward border), regardless of Religious Faith. Girls that are enrolled in St. Anne's CCD program do receive preference in sign-ups, and as members on a team.

This program is run in grades 3 – 8, but we do allow girls in grades 2 to sign up and they would play on the 3rd grade team. Girls must register for the team/grade, as the grade they are in school this year.

To register your child in St. Anne's Girls Basketball Program, please print out the following forms, the forms must be filled out completely;

Pg. 1, Registration/Health Form.

Pg. 2, Parental Permission/Waiver of Liability Form.

Pg. 3, 4, Code of Conduct Agreement.

Pg. 5, St. Anne Girl's Basketball House Rules.

Pg. 6, Parish Boundaries Map, if your child isn't in our CCD program, than you must circle or highlight the street on the map that you live on.

Along with the above forms, you need to enclose a photo copy of your child's birth certificate and a copy(1) of a current utility bill for each child you are going to register (home phone bill, PG&E bill, or garbage bill, we will not except a copy of your drivers license, cell phone bill, or bank/mortgage statements).

Cost/Fees to play, first child \$75.00, additional children \$70.00.

Uniforms, if your child is new to our program, or needs a new uniform to replace last years uniform, the cost of the uniforms are \$45.00 for adult sizes, and \$40.00 for youth sizes (you will own these uniforms, and they may be worn for as long as they fit). If you would like to purchase a T-shirt for under your child's jersey, you may purchase one from us for \$5.00. We have set up a date at St. Anne's Parish for those who would like to check on the size of the uniform from our sample size uniforms, the date for that is Monday, January 16, 2006 from 7pm – 9pm in room 101, or you may contact Debbie and make arrangements.

Practices, we hold our practices at Alvarado Middle School in the gym. We will start our practices the first week of February, in Feb. the boy's basketball program will still be going on, but starting to wrap up, as the boy's team's complete their season, we will be moving the girl's teams into their permanent days and times for practices, but we may need to use different days and times at first, until the boys finish. Once we get settled, the girl's normal practice days and times will be; girls in grades 3,4,5, Tue. and Thurs. from 6-730pm, and girls grades 6,7,8, will be Tue. and Thurs. from 730-9pm.

REMEMBER, all forms must be filled out completely, you must provide us with the birth certificate and utility bill for each child. Girls will be registered on the team when the registration forms are received, if the forms have not been filled out completely, or

you haven't provided us with the supporting documents that we need, than your child will not be registered until you provide us with the balance of the information/documents that we need.

**Parental Permission and Acknowledgement of
Conditions for Participation in Program**

1. I/we, parent or authorized guardian of the child named above give permission for his/her participation in **(circle all that apply)**:
→ basketball cross country softball track & field volleyball cheerleading and all related activities, including but not limited to transportation to and from games or practice sessions.
2. I/we agree to direct my/our child to cooperate and comply with reasonable directions and instructions from CYO staff or adult volunteer leaders (coaches).
3. I/we agree to be responsible for all medical expenses relating to injury of my/our child as a result of his/her participation in any sport activity, whether or not caused by the negligence of parish, school, or CYO program employees, agents or volunteers or other participants.
4. I/we understand that children competing in athletic and recreational sports programs risk injury to the body, psyche or property damage to themselves and others. Such injuries can be caused by teammates, other persons or accidentally or intentionally self inflicted, faulty equipment or facilities, conditions of recreational facilities or the schools or parishes where sports activities are held, vehicle accidents while in transport or through the activity itself. Protective equipment used in a sports activity is not a safeguard against injury.

RELEASE AND WAIVER OF LIABILITY AND INDEMNITY AGREEMENT

In consideration for being permitted to participate in the sports activities of CYO, use the equipment provided and to enter the premises or facilities of the Diocese of Oakland (Diocese) for any purpose including observation and participation in activities, the parent or guardian for him or herself and any successors in interest and on behalf of the minor child agrees:

1. To release, waive, discharge and promise not to sue the Diocese of Oakland, and its affiliated entities, its officers, directors, employees, agents and volunteers (hereafter referred to as "Releasees") from all liability for any loss or damage, and any claim or demands therefor on account of serious or mortal injury to the body, injury to psyche or property of the minor child, or undersigned parent or guardian, whether caused by negligence or other conduct by the Releasees while the minor child, parent or guardian is participating in CYO sports activities or in, upon or about the premises of the Diocese or any of its facilities or equipment.
2. To indemnify and hold harmless the Releasees from any loss, liability, damage or cost it may incur due to the presence of the minor child, parent or guardian in, upon or about the premises of the Diocese, its facilities or equipment, or while participating in any CYO sports activities whether caused by the negligence of Releasees or otherwise.
3. That the parent or guardian has read this Agreement, voluntarily signs the Agreement and that no oral representations, statements or inducements apart from the contents of this written Agreement have been made.

DIOCESE OF OAKLAND - CATHOLIC YOUTH ORGANIZATION CODE OF CONDUCT

The Catholic Youth Organization (CYO), through the vehicle of sports, provides youth with an opportunity to practice Christian attitudes and responsibilities and to become friends with other children throughout the diocese. CYO activities should be examples of the meaning of Christian sportsmanship. The guiding principle behind the enforcement of this code is that the behavior of everyone involved in CYO should not detract from the childrens' enjoyment of the sport.

1. COACHES

Acceptable standards of coaching behavior include:

- Set a good example for participants and fans to follow, exemplifying the highest moral and ethical behavior;
- Respect the judgment of officials; abide by rules of the event;
- Treat opposing coaches, participants and fans with respect;
- Instruct participants in sportsmanship and demand they display good sportsmanship;
- Coach in a positive manner, reflecting Christian values;
- In basketball and volleyball, remain seated on the bench at all times except in the instances in the National Federation Basketball Rule book.

Penalties:

- Any coach ejected from a game/match because of unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended for the next two games/matches and may be subject to additional penalties.
- Any coach who physically abuses another person may be suspended for the remainder of the season and may be disqualified from CYO participation
- Any coach who physically abuses an official will be suspended for the remainder of the season and may be disqualified from CYO participation.

2. PLAYERS

Acceptable standards of participant behavior include:

- Treat opponents with respect; shake hands prior to and after contests;
- Respect the judgment of officials and abide by the rules of the contest;
- Accept seriously the responsibility of representing the school or parish by displaying positive behavior at all times;
- Play in a positive manner, reflecting Christian values. Do not bait or taunt opponents.

Penalties:

- Any player ejected from a game/match because of unsportsmanlike conduct will be suspended from the next game and may be subject to additional penalties.
- Any player who physically abuses another player, participant or official may be suspended from play for the remainder of the season and may be disqualified from CYO competition.

3. SPECTATORS

Acceptable standards of spectator behavior include:

- Remember that the players are children and are playing for their enjoyment, not yours.
- Remain seated in the spectator area during the games;
- Respect decisions made by contest officials;
- Be a role model by positively supporting teams and by not shouting instructions or criticism to the players, coaches or officials. Do not coach from the stands;
- Make no derogatory comments or gestures to players, coaches, parents of the opposing team, officials or league administrators.

Penalties:

- Participating teams and their coaches are responsible for the conduct of their spectators.
- Any spectator who displays poor sportsmanship may be removed from the facility by an official, their team coach, a league official or the host gym person-in-charge.
- Any spectator who interferes with the conduct of a CYO activity may, at the discretion of the spectator's parish, league, or the Oakland Diocese, be barred from attendance at subsequent CYO activities.

4. ENFORCEMENT

The parishes and leagues, under the supervision of the Diocesan CYO Office, shall enforce this code. Complaints regarding violations of this code shall be first brought to the attention of the athletic directors of the parishes / schools involved. Coaches, participants or spectators may be placed on probation or suspended from CYO activities for their actions.

ST. ANNE CYO GIRL'S BASKETBALL

Parents/Guardians, Please read and initial each item and sign at the bottom.

_____ Children participating in the girls basketball program must live within the boundaries of St. Anne Parish (West of Hwy 880, North of the Alameda Creek, by Lowry Ave in Fremont and Union City, and up to the Union City/Hayward border) or be enrolled in the CCD program at St. Anne. If a child is found to be on a Parish team, that doesn't live in that parish's boundaries, or is not enrolled in the parish's CCD program, that child will be removed from the team by the league and the team will forfeit any games they have won.

_____ If a girl wants to wear a t-shirt under her jersey, it must be yellow/gold in color, so that it is close to our primary uniform color. They may not wear white, black, or any other color. You may buy one from us, or get you own.

_____ Children are to be dropped off and picked-up from practice. Children are not to walk home from practice.

_____ St. Anne CYO doesn't provide baby sitting services. You should only drop off children who are going to be participating in a scheduled practice. Parents and family members are welcome to come to practices and watch. Adults and children not in our cyo program, may not play in the gym.

_____ Water is the only thing that maybe brought into a practice, and/or game gym. No Food, Coffee, Sodas, or Sport Drink is allowed in gyms.

_____ There are no restrooms available for children to use during practice. At times the Holly Ctr. is open. Please see that children use the facilities before coming to practice.

_____ We encourage you to work with your child, but during practice or a game, you may not coach your child, the coach, or the official on the court.

_____ Everyone in this program is a volunteer. No one is paid. If you are interested in helping, please contact the Athletic Director or your child's coach.

_____ If the girl's team is coached by a male coach, there must be at least one adult female at each practice, this is to protect our children and the coach.
