The Liturgy Action Team recently asked you for insights about the motivation behind members of your group, and you are running out of time to reply!

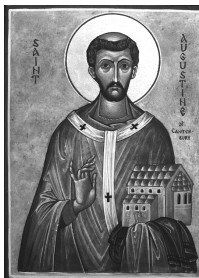
