There will be Mass Monday August 30th at St. Joseph at 6:00 pm, Tuesday August 31st at 6:00 pm at St. Mark and Wednesday September 1st at 8:00 am at St. Joseph.

Starting the Monday after Labor Day, Fr. Bob's weekly schedule will be reversed so that the weekday Masses are on Thursday and Friday mornings at St. Joseph at 8:00 am and Saturday morning at St. Mark at 9:00 am. The schedule was reversed so that First Friday's and Saturday's would be celebrated at St. Joseph and St. Mark.
